This is the latest version of an electronic library of resources on the China's engagement in South America and the Caribbean. It is composed of free, open on-line resources and, to keep the library manageable, it omits individual country studies. The library is intended to offer support to teachers and students studying the BRI as part of their undergraduate education and to act as a springboard to individual projects. The core of the New Silk Roads project has been focussed on Eurasia (and the original list published by the National Development and Reform Commission). However, the extension of China's Belt and Road initiative towards South America justifies an extension of the project's focus. Any suggestions will be welcome.
